The John Barton Payne Community Hall lends itself to a variety of events.

Fauquier Public Library has two meeting spaces, the John Barton Payne Community Hall (across the street from the Warrenton central library) and the Bealeton Depot (adjacent to the Bealeton branch library).

When not in use for library programs, the buildings are available to rent.



In 1921, Judge John Barton Payne, a Secretary of the Interior under President Wilson who had family ties to Fauquier County, provided funds for a permanent building for the Warrenton Library. Now known as the John Barton Payne Community Hall, the building was home to the Library from 1922 until 1982.

The Bealeton Depot, built around 1905, was a stop on the rail route from southern Fauquier County to Washington, D.C. The depot was decommissioned in the 1950s. Later it was moved to its current location adjacent to the Bealeton Library.

Restored in 2010, the Bealeton Depot's 800-square-foot room serves as meeting space for groups engaged in educational, cultural, intellectual, charitable or civic activities as well as businesses who wish to use the room for educational meetings and training purposes.
